

# SAN JOSE MIDDLE SCHOOL PTA Planning Survey 2021/22 Results

**Overview:** For eight (8) weeks from July 20 to September 12, 2021, the SJMS PTA collected input from parents through an electronic survey published on the school website at <a href="mailto:sanjose.nusd.org/ptasurvey2021">sanjose.nusd.org/ptasurvey2021</a>. Parents were invited to participate through emails from the Principal to all families, Facebook posts, and an in-person announcement at a PTA meeting. We received 76 responses. What language are you most comfortable using for communications? 73 responses




Do you plan to use the Bridge After-School Program this year? 76 responses




Would you be interested in seeing more options for after-school enrichment activities for SJMS students?


Would you be interested in any ONLINE / REMOTE after-school activities?

71 responses




Do the parents / primary care providers in your family tend to work outside the home during school days?

74 responses




Which of the following might your child be most interested in trying for after-school enrichment activities? (Select up to 4.)


We're planning some Parent Education sessions. What topics would you be interested in attending? (Select all that apply.)




Have you ever been to a PTA Meeting?




Which of these times are best for you to attend PTA meetings? (Select any that apply.) 75 responses
